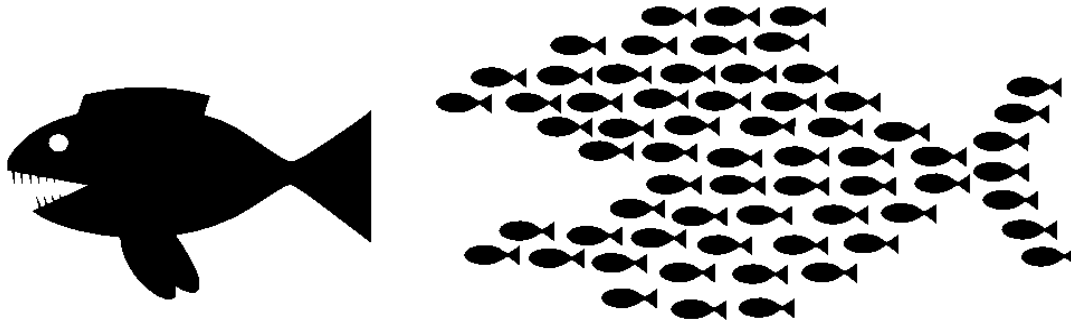


FIGHT WORKFARE: ORGANISE AT WORK!

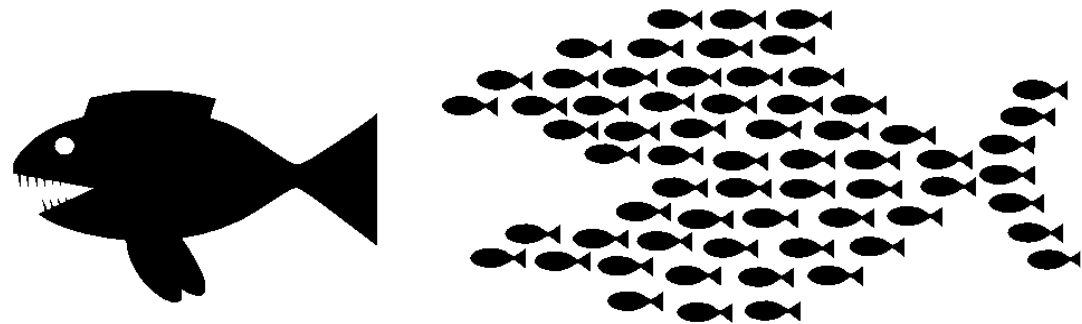
